CSG Data Privacy Framework Notice

This Data Privacy Framework Notice ("DPF Notice") sets out the principles we follow with

Third Parties: Information about the types of third parties to which we disclose personal

received your personal data in the U.S. and subsequently transfer that information to a third

party acting as our agent, and that agent processes your personal data in a manner inconsistent with the DPF Principles, then we will remain liable unless we can prove we are not responsible for the event giving rise to the damage.

Your Rights: If you are located in the EEA or UK, you have the right to request access to the personal data that we hold about you and request that we correct, amend, or delete your personal data if it is inaccurate or processed in violation of the DPF.
